- 4. WHENEVER THIS TANK IS PAINTED, R-1113 MUST BE COMPLIED WITH.
- 5. THA TANKS ROOFS SHALL BE VAPOR-TIGHT AND BE EQUIPPED WITH A PRESSURE-VACUUM VALVE WHICH SHALL BE SET WITHIN 10 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE WORKING PRESSURE OF THE TANKS.
