SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF TIME EXTENSION REQUEST FOR SUBMITTAL OF TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA WATER CODE SECTION 13267 ORDER

SITE: S & C Oil Company, Incorporated, Huntington Beach, California.

Dear Mr. Williams:

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) has received a written response, dated January 8, 2016 (attached), for an extension to submit a technical report (Report) required under investigative order R4-2015-0382 under the California Water Code (CWC) Section 13267 Order for the site. The original due date for the Report was January 18, 2016. The requested new due date for the Report is March 4, 2016.

The extension is being requested due to the discovery of one redwood lined sump, which held produced water. The lease was purchased in January of 1988, and the sump was discontinued shortly thereafter. This extension would allow sufficient time to collect the necessary documents required to produce a technical report to fulfill the requirements of the Order for the site. The Regional Board hereby approves the request for the extension of the Report due date to **March 4, 2016**.

The above requirement for submittal of a technical report constitutes an amendment to the requirements of the California Water Code section 13267 Order originally dated December 18, 2015. All other aspects of the Order originally dated December 18, 2015, and the amendments thereto, remain in full force and effect. The required technical report is necessary to investigate the characteristics of and extend of the discharges of waste at the site and to evaluate cleanup alternatives, if needed. Therefore, the burden, including costs, of the report bear a reasonable relationship to the need for the report and benefits to be obtained. Pursuant to section 13268 of the California Water Code, failure to submit the required technical report by the specified due date may result in civil liability administratively imposed by the Regional Board in an amount up to one thousand dollars (\$1000) for each day each technical report is not received.




