We received your letter on Dec 21, 2015 regarding sumps and the potential disposal of well drilling and completion fluids to land in Los Angeles and Ventura County, CA.

We operate two production sites in the West Whittier Field in LA County. There are no sumps, and to our knowledge, there has never been any sumps within our production sites.

We have drilled wells at our West Whittier production site. All of the drilling and completion fluids were captured in tanks and disposed of or recycled by third party vendors. No fluids were discharged into sumps or ponds.
