### Equipment Description :

CRUDE OIL PRODUCTION / SEPARATION SYSTEM CONSISTING OF:

1. WASH TANK NO. E-193, 27'-9" DIA. X 8'-0" H., 800 BARRELS CAPACITY, FIXED ROOF, WITH A TRANSFER PUMP, CENTRIFUGAL, 5 H.P., AND VENTED TO A VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM.
2. SHIPPING TANK NO. E-194, 27'-9" DIA. X 8'-0" H., 800 BARRELS CAPACITY, FIXED ROOF, WITH A TRANSFER PUMP, RECIPROCATING, 60 H.P., AND VENTED TO A VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM.
3. SKIM TANK, 8'-0" DIA. X 6'-0" H., 50 BARRELS CAPACITY, FIXED ROOF, WITH A TRANSFER PUMP, CENTRIFUGAL, 1 H.P., AND VENTED TO A VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM.
4. THREE OIL-GAS SEPARATORS, EACH 2'-6" DIA. X 10'-0" H.
5. THREE CHEMICAL TANKS, EACH 3'-2" W. X 3'-2" L. X 3'-2" D., 200-GALLON CAPACITY.
6. DRAINAGE PIT, 5'-0" W. X 20'-0" L. X 6'-0" D., COVERED, WITH A P/V RELIEF VALVE, A TRANSFER PUMP, 2 H.P., AND VENTED TO A VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM.
7. VAPOR RECOVERY COMPRESSOR, 20 H.P., WITH DISCHARGE TO GAS GATHERING LINE.
8. TANK TRUCK CRUDE LOADING STATION WITH A 2" BOTTOM LOADING CONNECTOR AND A 2" VAPOR RETURN LINE.

### Conditions :

1. OPERATION OF THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL DATA AND SPECIFICATIONS SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION UNDER WHICH THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED BELOW.
2. THIS EQUIPMENT SHALL BE PROPERLY MAINTAINED AND KEPT IN GOOD OPERATING CONDITION AT ALL TIMES.
3. THIS FACILITY SHALL NOT BE OPERATED UNLESS THE WASH TANK, SHIPPING TANK, SKIM TANK, AND DRAINAGE PIT ARE VENTED TO THE VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM

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WHICH IS IN FULL USE.

4. THE OPERATOR SHALL COMPLY WITH THE APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF RULES 463, 466, 466.1, 1148.1, 1173 AND 1176.
5. ALL TANK GAUGING AND SAMPLING HATCHES SHALL BE CLOSED AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT DURING GAUGING AND SAMPLING OPERATIONS.
6. ALL REQUIRED INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR RECORDS SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A FORMAT APPROVED BY THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER, KEPT ON FILE FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, AND MADE AVAILABLE TO DISTRICT PERSONNEL UPON REQUEST.

**NOTICE**

IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE 206, THIS PERMIT TO OPERATE OR COPY SHALL BE POSTED ON OR WITHIN 8 METERS OF THE EQUIPMENT.

THIS PERMIT DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE EMISSION OF AIR CONTAMINANTS IN EXCESS OF THOSE ALLOWED BY DIVISION 26 OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OR THE RULES OF THE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.
