The purpose of this email is to formally requests an extension for the submittal of the Technical Report requested in the December 18<sup>th</sup> letter, signed by Paula Rasmussen.

As discussed, you are requesting a very significant amount of data and if I am going to prepare an accurate and comprehensive report as you are requesting, I do not believe that I can possibly provide this to you by January 18<sup>th</sup>. I have already contacted our environmental consulting firm, Sespe and have them starting on the maps are aerial you are requesting, with labels for various site features. They tell me they will "try" to get this done within two weeks. I have talked with Jeff Dorrington of the Ventura County Watershed Protection District and he will be identifying well locations within a one mile radius of our facility and providing any water quality data that he has associated with these wells. I have also called the City of Oxnard and am trying to get in touch with someone from their Water Department who will be able to provide me with similar date to what Jeff Dorrington is providing. Today I will be contacting the County of LA to try to gather similar data for our Tapia well in Castaic.

My analytical lab cannot come out to our sites until next week and once they sample, their turn-around time on analyticals will be two to three weeks.

Therefore, I respectfully request that you allow Anterra Energy Services and Anterra Services to submit these Technical Reports to you by January 29<sup>th</sup>.
