Ample Resources, Inc. (hereafter referred to as Ample) is in receipt of your letter dated December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2015 regarding Investigative Order No.R4-2015-0471 to provide a technical or monitoring report on the disposal of well drilling fluids, well completion fluids, and production fluids to land for Ample Resources, Incorporated oil and gas operations in Los Angeles and Ventura County, California – California Water Code Section 13267.

**Ample Resources, Inc. submits certification by this letter that during the period that Ample or its subsidiary has owned or operated the oilfield or field in Ventura County that Ample has NOT discharged any well drilling fluid, well completion fluid, and well production fluid to sump. Ample does not and has never operated in Los Angeles County.**

Ample Resources, Inc. water disposal method regarding oil and gas operations is disposal to a fully permitted and fully inspected and compliant (by County, State, and Federal BLM) water disposal well on Ample's lease.
