Subject: Follow-up Correspondence to 22 April 2016 Notice of Violation – Regarding Order No. R4-2015-0473 Order to Submit Information – Disposal of Well Drilling Fluids, Well Completion Fluids, and Production Fluids to Land for Future Energy LLC Oil and Gas Operations in Los Angeles and Ventura County, California.

Dear Mr. Cwikla:

Future Energy LLC (FE-1) leases land for the development of oil and gas in the Tapia Oilfield located in Los Angeles County. FE-1 current lease holdings are not producing and land storage of drilling fluids, well completion fluids, or produced fluids has not occurred at any time during FE-1 operations. Once production activities resume FE-1 will contract the disposal of fluids to Southern California Waste Water that will truck the fluids to their disposal facility. Fluids will be temporarily stored at the well site in above ground wastewater storage tank(s) prior to removal by the waste water disposal company.
