# PROPOSED SETTLEMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT NO. R4-2025-0268 (THE BOEING COMPANY)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board) will consider whether to adopt a proposed settlement between the Los Angeles Water Board Prosecution Team and The Boeing Company related to Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R4-2025-0268 (ACL Complaint). On December 1, 2025, the Assistant Executive Officer issued the ACL Complaint on behalf of the Los Angeles Water Board Prosecution Team against The Boeing Company. The ACL Complaint alleged thirtynine (39) effluent limitation violations of The Boeing Company's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits at the Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL) from January 2023 to March 2025. The Los Angeles Water Board Prosecution Team proposed a five hundred ninety-five thousand twenty-six dollar (\$595,026) penalty for the alleged violations using the State Water Resources Control Board's Water Quality Enforcement Policy. On December 10, 2025, The Boeing Company submitted a signed Waiver Form to waive its right to a hearing and agreed to pay the proposed penalty. The Los Angeles Water Board is accepting written comments on this proposed settlement.
