Our notice dated July 12, 2016, informed you that the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) will hold a public hearing to receive comments and evidence, and consider adoption of, a proposed amendment to the Waste Discharge Requirements for Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Discharges within the Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles County, Except those Discharges Originating from the City of Long Beach MS4 (NPDES No. CAS004001; Order No. R4-2012-0175) ("LA County MS4 Permit") to incorporate modifications consistent with the recently revised Los Angeles River Watershed Trash Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) and the Ballona Creek Watershed Trash TMDL.
