
The Lower San Gabriel River Watershed Committee (cities of Artesia, Bellflower, Cerritos, Diamond Bar, Downey, Hawaiian Gardens, La Mirada, Lakewood, Long Beach, Norwalk, Pico Rivera, Santa Fe Springs, Whittier and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District (LACFCD)) is submitting the enclosed Semi-Annual Data Report for the Lower San Gabriel River Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP). The Report is being submitted electronically in the California Environmental Data Exchange Network (CEDEN) format. Electronic data are organized in folders first by the group conducting each monitoring activity. The LACFCD conducted all monitoring activities performed in 2015. Subdirectories are included under the monitoring group for chemical measurements, flow measurements, field data and aquatic toxicity where applicable. Parameters measured in excess of the appropriate criteria have been highlighted in the files.

Between the reporting period of July 1 through December 31, 2015, the following events were conducted:

1. On July 29, 2015, the LACFCD conducted dry weather sampling at Mass Emission Station (MES) S13. Sampling included all Table E-2 parameters, field measurements and aquatic toxicity.

2. On December 14, 2015, the Group conducted wet weather sampling at MES S13 in Coyote Creek. Sampling included Table E-2 parameters, field measurements and aquatic toxicity. Rainfall measured at the station during this event was not sufficient to apply the High Flow Suspension for Recreational Beneficial Uses.
