Subject: Submittal of 2018-2019 Semi-Annual Report, for the Upper Santa Clara River
Coordinated Integrated Monitoring Program (CIMP)

The City of Santa Clarita along with the County of Los Angeles; County Flood Control District (LACFCD), and the Upper Santa Clara River Watershed Management Group would like to submit the enclosed (CIMP) Semi-Annual Report.

The Report is submitted in the California Environmental Data Exchange Network (CEDEN) format. During the reporting period from July 1 through December 31, 2018, one wet and one dry weather monitoring events were conducted, as well as weekly bacteria monitoring at the three reaches:

1. Dry weather event #1 – July 11, 2018
2. Wet Weather event #1 – November 29, 2018
3. Weekly sampling for bacteria (total coliform, fecal coliform, and enterococcus) at receiving water sites (SNTCLR_5_R-E, SNTCLR_6_ME, and SNTCLR_7_R-A) pursuant to the Indicator Bacteria in the Santa Clara River Estuary and Reaches 3, 5, 6, and 7 (Bacteria TMDL)
