

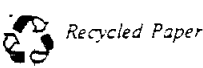

This Notice of Decision is to advise you that the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) has determined that the above referenced project has been approved. On January 27, 1997, the Regional Board adopted an amendment to the *Water Quality Control Plan for the Los Angeles Region (Basin Plan)*; namely Resolution 97-02 ("Amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan to incorporate a Policy for Addressing Levels of Chloride in Discharges of Wastewaters"). This amendment was subsequently approved by the State Water Resources Control Board (Resolution No. 97-94), and by the Office of Administrative Law (see attached memorandum dated January 29, 1998).
