## Section 3939.56: Groundwater Quality Management Measures for Salts and Nutrients in the Raymond Groundwater Basin in Los Angeles County

On December 8, 2016, the Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Los Angeles Water Board) adopted Resolution No. R16-011 to incorporate stakeholderdeveloped groundwater quality management measures for salts and nutrients in the Raymond Groundwater Basin of Los Angeles County. The State Water Resources Control Board approved the amendment under Resolution No. 2017-0029, on May 16, 2017.

Resolution No. R16-011 amends the Los Angeles Region's Basin Plan by incorporating stakeholder-developed groundwater quality management measures, contained in the Salt and Nutrient Management Plan (SNMP) for the Raymond Groundwater Basin in Los Angeles County, into Chapter 8 "Groundwater Quality Management – Sustainability and Basin-specific Protection of Groundwater". The SNMP compiles existing salt and nutrient loading information for the Raymond Basin and uses existing water quality objectives established in Chapter 3 of the Los Angeles Region Basin Plan and current water quality information to determine available assimilative capacities to be used when evaluating the effectiveness of existing and potential salt and nutrient management strategies for salt and nutrients are designed to provide a framework for the long-term management of salts and nutrients in the Raymond Basin, while supporting increased use of recycled water. These strategies will be applied in conjunction with already existing groundwater quality protection measures in the planning area (e.g. cleanup operations).
