NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) will hold a public hearing on the Underground Storage Tank's Nominations for the Annual Priority List, EAR Account. Written and oral comments will be accepted at the hearing. The Regional Board will take formal action on the Tentative Resolution to adopt a Resolution affirming the nominations. There are six new sites and one renewal from the current fiscal year. These contaminated sites threaten or have already impacted groundwater quality, but complete assessment and cleanup have been stalled because the responsible parties have been recalcitrant. Adoption for the 2012-2013 Annual Priority List will provide funding for further assessment as required.
