RECISION OF  
WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
ORDER NO. 89-38

FOR

SIERRA PACIFIC INDUSTRIES  
HAYFORK DIVISION

Trinity County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (hereinafter Regional Water Board) finds that:

1. On June 22, 1989, the Regional Water Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 89-38 (Order No. 89-38) for Sierra Pacific Industries, Hayfork Division (hereinafter discharger), sawmill located adjacent to Hayfork Creek on the east side of the town of Hayfork.
2. On May 4, 1998, the discharger notified the Regional Water Board that the sawmill and planer mill were dismantled in 1996. The machinery, equipment, and buildings were removed and the operation is no longer active. Therefore, the waste discharge requirements under Order No. 89-38 are no longer necessary or required.
3. The action to rescind Waste Discharge Requirements is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), at Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq., pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Sections 15060(c)(2) and 15061(b).
4. The Regional Water Board has notified the discharger and interested agencies and persons of its intent to rescind Order No. 89-38 and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.
5. The Regional Water Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this matter.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. 89-38 for Sierra Pacific Industries, Hayfork Division, is rescinded.
