MONITORING

1. The depth to groundwater in each monitoring well shall be determined to at least 0.01 foot increments quarterly. The results of each quarter's elevation shall be reported in tabular form indicating the surveyed elevations of each well reference point, depth to groundwater from reference point, and the actual groundwater elevation. The data generated from the elevation readings must be referenced to mean sea level.
2. Monitoring wells M-7, MW-101, MW-104, and MW-106 shall be sampled quarterly for two years followed by semiannually for three years. The analyses shall be performed at a certified laboratory for pentachlorophenol and tetrachlorophenol.

REPORTING

A groundwater elevation contour map shall be submitted for each set of measurements and include the facility, groundwater flow pattern including the direction of the groundwater gradient, and the location of the wells measured. Quarterly monitoring reports, including quarterly gradient data and quarterly sampling data, shall be submitted to this office in accordance with the following schedule until December of 2003:

October, November, December	January 15

Semiannual monitoring reports, including semiannual gradient data and semiannual sampling data, shall be submitted to this office in accordance with the following schedule from January 2004 until December of 2006:

July, August, September, October, November, December	January 15
