## **RESOLUTION NO. R1-2018-0052**

## APPROVING THE LOCAL AGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE COUNTY OF MENDOCINO

WHEREAS, The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (hereafter North Coast Regional Water Board) finds:

- 1. On June 19, 2012, the State Water Resources Control Board (hereafter State Water Board) adopted Resolution No. 2012-0032, which in part approves the *Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems* (hereafter the OWTS Policy);
- 2. The OWTS Policy allows a local agency to propose a Local Agency Management Program (hereafter LAMP) to the North Coast Regional Water Board for approval;
- 3. The OWTS Policy requires the establishment of an Advanced Protection Management Program (APMP) that establishes standards and requirements for onsite wastewater treatment systems (OWTS) near impaired water bodies;
- 4. When a Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) is adopted by a regional water board, the local agency must ensure that its LAMP is consistent with the TMDL program of implementation;
- 5. The Russian River Watershed, part of which are located in Mendocino County, is being addressed by a program of implementation as part of the North Coast Regional Water Board Russian River Watershed Pathogen TMDL (Russian River Watershed Pathogen TMDL);
- 6. The OWTS Policy requires North Coast Regional Water Board staff to solicit comments from the State Water Board Division of Drinking Water (DDW) regarding the LAMP's proposed setbacks and notifications to water purveyors prior to OWTS permitting;
- 7. On May 20, 2016, the County of Mendocino submitted a draft LAMP to Regional Water Board staff;
- 8. On July 7, 2016, the State Water Board DDW submitted comments on the draft LAMP to staff from the Mendocino County Department of Public Works, Environmental Health Division;

- 9. On November 11, 2016, the North Coast Regional Water Board staff submitted comments on the draft LAMP to staff from the Mendocino County Department of Public Works, Environmental Health Division;
- 10. North Coast Regional Water Board staff entered into discussions with Mendocino County staff regarding the draft LAMP and its consistency with the OWTS Policy and agreed upon acceptable revisions to the draft LAMP;
- 11. On June 19, 2018, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors approved the revised draft LAMP and submitted it to the North Coast Regional Water Board for its approval;
- 12. As set forth in its LAMP, the County of Mendocino will incorporate requirements of the Russian River Watershed Pathogen TMDL program of implementation by amending its LAMP as soon as practicable;
- 13. On August 16, 2018, the North Coast Water Regional Water Board notified the County and interested parties of its intent to approve the LAMP and provided them with an opportunity to submit comments and recommendations concerning the proposed Resolution No. R1-2018-0052;
- 14. On November 14-15, 2018, the North Coast Regional Water Board, in a public meeting, heard and considered all comments pertaining to this action.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that that the North Coast Regional Water Board hereby approves the Mendocino County Local Agency Management Program (approved on June 19, 2018 by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors).
