Proposed Time Schedule Order (TSO) No. R1-2019-0011 for the City of Arcata Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility) is ready for review. The Facility is currently regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2012-0031 and will be regulated by Waste Discharge Requirements, Order No. R1-2019-0006, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0022713, WDID No. 1B82114OHUM proposed for adoption by the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) on June 19 or 20, 2019, with a proposed effective date of August 1, 2019. The Facility will be unable to comply with all requirements contained in the proposed NPDES permit. Proposed TSO No. R1-2019-0011 provides a list of tasks and associated schedule of deadlines to achieve full compliance with requirements in the proposed Permit.

The Regional Water Board Executive Officer intends to issue the Proposed TSO following a 30-day public comment period. Any comments received will be reviewed and responded to, as needed. If significant comments are received, the Proposed TSO may be scheduled for a hearing before the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board.
