OWTS Policy Timeline

Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation, and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems

Adoption Date:	June 19, 2012
Effective Date:	May 13, 2013
Regional Board Adoption:	June 18, 2015
Deadline to submit draft LAMP for review:	May 13, 2016
Deadline for LAMP approval:	May 13, 2018



OWTS Policy

- **Tier 1** 3,500 gpd or less, prescriptive standards
- Tier 2 10,000 gpd or less, local requirements in LAMP
- **Tier 3** OWTS near impaired water bodies, requirements set forth in Advanced Protection Management Program (APMP)
 - Alternative No.1 Minimum standards in OWTS Policy (default)
 - Alternative No. 2 APMP defined, requirements set forth in TMDL
 - Alternative No. 3 APMP as special provisions in approved LAMP
- **Tier 4** OWTS requiring corrective action, local requirements in LAMP
- Tier 0 10,000 gpd or less, low strength, not in Tier 3 or Tier 4



Local Agency Management Program (LAMP)

Purpose: Allow local agencies to establish alternative standards to Tier 1 to accommodate local site conditions

Minimum Requirements:

- Standards for siting, design, operation, construction
- Requirements for maintenance, monitoring, variances, repairs
- Water Quality Assessment Program
- Annual Report and 5-year Program Evaluation Report

LAMPs may include:

- Special provisions for OWTS near impaired areas
- Oversight agreements



Humboldt County LAMP Development

Local participation and approval:

- Public comments:August 2015 to March 2016
- Board of Supervisors approved:November 2017

Regional Water Board process:

- Draft LAMP submitted:April 2016
- Regional Water Board staff comments:February 2017
- Interagency discussions concluded:May 2017
- Regional Water Board Hearing:February 8, 2018



Humboldt County LAMP

- Meets minimum requirements of OWTS Policy
- Establishes special provisions for impaired water bodies
 - Clam Beach, Luffenholtz Beach, Moonstone County Park, Trinidad State
 Beach
 - Public education, evaluation of existing OWTS, monitoring, protective criteria for new and replacement OWTS
- OWTS oversight agreements with other local agencies
 - Arcata, Trinidad, Rio Dell, Ferndale
