SUBJECT: THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA, OCTOBER 2013 NON-STORM WATER

DISCHARGE BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICE PLAN

On October 1, 2009, The North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R1-2009-0050 for the City of Santa Rosa, et al Storm Water and Non-Storm Water Discharges from Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4), NPDES No. CA0025054 (Permit). Permit Section A.5.(c) includes the option for the City of Santa Rosa to submit a Best Management Practice (BMP) Plan to apply for authorization from the Executive Officer to allow specific non-storm water flows into the MS4.

The City of Santa Rosa staff initially submitted a BMP Plan in May 2010. Regional Water Board staff provided comments on this version and has worked with the City of Santa Rosa on developing the current version. The Regional Water Board Executive Officer is considering the current version for approval. The current BMP plan is attached to this notice.

The Permit requires the plan to be noticed for public review and comment prior to approval. Comments must be submitted in writing by 5:00 p.m. on December 11, 2013. Comments may be submitted to:
