Regional Water Board staff propose that no further work be required at the abovereferenced site. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

Industrial machining and manufacturing operations began at the site around 1945 and continued until 1996. Numerous investigations and cleanup actions have been completed. Environmental investigations documented soil and groundwater contamination, including hexavalent chromium and other metals, volatile organic compounds, 1,4-dioxane, petroleum hydrocarbons, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, and polychlorinated biphenyls. Cleanup actions included excavations, in-situ bioremediation, groundwater extraction and treatment, and monitored natural attenuation. Land use restrictions have been filed with the County of Mendocino to further protect environmental and human health into the future.

Proposed Action

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plan to proceed with the case closure process upon conclusion of the comment period.
