Soil and groundwater was investigated at the above referenced site due to the unauthorized discharge of waste. Remediation was performed, and this site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's Resolution 92-49. Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

In October 2008, the City of Ukiah Police observed the unauthorized dumping of waste materials from a trailer-mounted tank onto the bank of a flood control channel at another location. The waste materials consisted of liquid and solid waste that had been removed from a local car washing facility. Subsequent laboratory analysis of the waste materials showed the presence of petroleum constituents and dichloromethane. Police were also informed that waste had been discharged at the Site. Soil and groundwater investigation was performed, with some soil contamination found; no groundwater contamination was present. Contaminated soil was subsequently excavated and properly disposed of.
