

The County of Sonoma, in collaboration with the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board, is soliciting volunteers to be part of a Community Advisory Group (CAG) that will provide input and recommendations for projects addressing failing septic systems in the lower Russian River. The first task of the CAG will be to provide input on the development of a Request for Proposal for consultant services for a draft planning study that will identify community-driven solutions to septic system challenges in the lower Russian River.
