

# **Existing Dairy Program Timeline**

- <u>2012</u> Adoption of Conditional Waiver R1-2012-0003 & General Waste Discharge Requirements R1-2012-0002
- 2016 Renewal of the Conditional Waiver
- <u>2018</u> Tentative Hearing for Consideration of Adoption of General Waste Discharge Requirements

# **Existing Reporting Submittals**

<b>Requirement</b>	<b><u>Timing</u></b>
Water Quality Plan	2012
Nutrient Management Plan	Required if > 700 milking+dry
Annual Report	November 30
Surface Water Monitoring (pH, temp., ammonia, electrical conductivity)	3 times /winter
<b>Groundwater Monitoring</b> (nitrate, fecal coliform)	4 samples in 2 years
Annual Fees	Due each December *Fee determined by SWRCB

# **Existing Requirements**

- Prohibitions
  - No waste discharge to surface water
  - No waste discharge to groundwater
- Statewide Water Quality Regulations for Confined Animal Facilities (CA Code of Regulations-Title 27)
  - Meet minimum standards
- Best Management Practices



# **Existing Dairy Program Benefits**

- Stewardship
- Education -CA Dairy Quality Assurance Program
- Nutrient Management Plans -(from 25% to 80+%)
- Support/Funding-
  - State Board Grants
  - Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS)
  - Resource Conservation Districts (RCD)
  - Western United Dairymen (WUD)
  - Farm Bureaus











## **The Need for Revised Permit**

- Waivers expire every 5 years
- Update Regulations and Requirements
- Coverage for New Dairies, Expanding Dairies, and Goat/Sheep/Water Buffalo



# **New Requirements to Consider**

### **Potentially Add:**

- Goat/Sheep/Water Buffalo Dairies
- New or Expanding Dairies

   -individual California
   Environmental Quality Act
   (CEQA) may be required
- Update Regulations
- Riparian Management Planning
- Nutrient Management Plans







#### **California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)**

- Lead Agency-NCRWQCB
- Public and State Clearinghouse Review (30 day)
- Tribal Consultation per Public Resources Code 21080.3.1 and 21080.3.2
- Response to Public Comments
- Hearing for Consideration of Adoption (2018)

  - By Mail



## **Tentative Schedule**

- <u>August 2017</u>- Public Stakeholder Meetings
- <u>September-November 2017</u>- Regional Water Board staff drafts the Dairy Permit
- <u>December 2017-January 2018</u>- Begin 30-day Public Review of the Draft Permit
- <u>January 2018</u>- Workshop on Draft Permit at Regional Water Board Meeting
- <u>Late-January to February 2018</u>- Close 30-day public review

- <u>February-March 2018</u>- Respond to public comments. Draft revised permit.
- <u>Spring/Summer 2018</u>- Regional Water Board Hearing to consider adoption of the Revised Dairy Permit
