North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board staff continues to draft modifications to the existing Dairy Program permits, including proposed waste discharge requirements (WDRs). The tentatively scheduled board workshop of May 17, 2018 has been postponed and a new board workshop to hear comments on the draft WDR has not been rescheduled. A public notice will be posted on our website in the future to announce the Regional Water Board workshop and tentative 30-day public review per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Modifications to the existing Dairy Program may include the addition of new dairies, expansion of existing dairies, re-opening of abandoned dairies, and sheep/goat/water buffalo dairies. Requirements for nutrient management plans, riparian management, and updated water quality and resource protection, are also being considered.
