The North Coast Water Board is developing an order that will require the inventory, assessment, and prioritization of sediment-generating rural roads in the Gualala River Watershed. This will be one of two orders designed to improve road conditions and control excess sediment and elevated water temperatures that reduce water quality and harm the river's ecosystem, particularly its native salmon and trout populations.

Sonoma Resource Conservation District (RCD) staff will be in attendance to connect with landowners and land managers in navigating this new water quality assessment order and provide on-the-ground technical assistance. The RCD provides non-regulatory, free assistance to our community.
