WHERE: Parkways Wetland Pond, Folsom

(Adjacent to Oak Chan Elementary School in Folsom)

DIRECTIONS TO THE TESTING SITE:

Highway 50 East

- Take the SCOTT ROAD/EAST BIDWELL STREET exit
- Turn LEFT onto SCOTT ROAD/EAST BIDWELL STREET
- Turn RIGHT onto OAK AVENUE PARKWAY
- Turn RIGHT onto BLUE RAVINE ROAD
- Turn RIGHT onto PARKWAY (The Parkway subdivision)
 - About 1_ blocks down, there is a bridge near some model homes. The beaver den is about 200 feet (and visible) from the end of the bridge. You may park on the street in front of the model homes.
