Governor Brown's State Water Board Appointee Tam Doduc Confirmed by State Senate

Today, the State Senate voted to confirm Tam Doduc as a member of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), following the January 8 recommendation by the Senate Rules Committee that she serve on the board. On March 13, 2013, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. re-appointed Doduc to the State Water Board.

The five member State Water Board is responsible for protecting all water quality and water supplies in California. The Board is also responsible for the allocation of surface water supplies for agricultural, public trust, and urban purposes throughout the state.

Doduc fills the position of the civil engineer with expertise in water supply and water rights and lives in Sacramento. Doduc's term expires January 17, 2017.

The Senate's action is a re-appointment to the State Water Resources Control Board, where she has served since 2005. Doduc has held multiple positions at the California Environmental Protection Agency since 2000, including deputy secretary for environmental quality, assistant secretary for air and chemical programs, assistant secretary for agriculture and chemical programs and assistant secretary for technology certification. She was an air resources engineer at the California Air Resources Board from 1997 to 2000 and was special assistant to the secretary at the California Environmental Protection Agency from 1995 to 1997. Doduc was a water resources engineer at the State Water Resources Control Board from 1994 to 1995 and was special assistant to the secretary at the California Environmental Protection Agency from 1993 to 1994. She was a water resources engineer at the State Water Resources Control Board from 1989 to 1992. Doduc has been a registered professional civil engineer since 1995.

She earned a Master of Business Administration degree from the University of California, Berkeley and a Master of Science degree in Civil Engineering from California State University, Sacramento.
