Destruction of multiple counties in the northern San Joaquin Valley is the end result of your proposal to require 40% (range of 30 – 50%) unimpeded from the Stanislaus, Tuolumne, and Merced rivers.

There is no justifiable basis for this proposed action. It is being driven by monetary and political interests in Southern California disparate for more water.

You cannot in good conscience approve this proposed action.

The final projects in the California Water Project were never built out due to efforts from environmental groups with limited interest in the welfare of California residents.
