I have read in the Calaveras Enterprise, usually a reliable source that, "According to the state agency, a total of 1,103 salmon would benefit from increasing water flows from the Stanislaus and Tuolumne rivers to 40 percent of the river flow, which is estimated to cost the region \$260 million in economic damage."
