I have read the proposed changes you are contemplating to the Irrigated Lands Program. I just wanted to take a moment a provide my perspective as a small farmer managing a 'specialty' bonsai nursery in El Dorado County. Most of the regulations do not apply to us as we are a typical "Mom and Pop" operation with a small budget and a minute impact on the problems you are attempting to solve, our water is supplied by EID. Regardless of our status the following items are important for you to consider:

- 1. We fill out a lot forms already. We do not have any impact on groundwater. We are in compliance with all local regulations and ordinances.
- 2. The value of our products is small and anything that adds cost to our production process will have a negative impact on our business.
- 3. Take the approach of the State Water Board Sustainable Groundwater Act and let local jurisdictions craft site specific programs to protect groundwater.
- 4. In many areas "Groundwater Basins" do not exist.
- 5. In our case we do not have a basin impacted by Nitrogen.
