RE: Comment Letter - SF Bay Region Beneficial Uses/Waterbodies Update

Adding the unnamed surface water bodies and designated beneficial uses for the San Francisco Bay Region is an essential step in protecting the Bay, its wildlife and fish habitat and all of the other beneficial uses that depend on it.

The health of the San Francisco Bay is important for the survival of all species and depends in large part of the on the quality of the Bay water. The ability of the State Board to regulate the quality of the Bay's water is central to maintaining and improving the Bay's water quality.

We have reviewed, in particular, the proposed changes for Marin County waterbodies. The changes will enable improved oversight and management of these important resources.
