NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

PROPOSED APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE SANTA ANA RIVER BASIN TO INCORPORATE REVISED TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS FOR NUTRIENTS IN LAKE ELSINORE AND CANYON LAKE, RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed approval of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region's (Santa Ana Water Board) Water Quality Control Plan for the Santa Ana River Basin (Basin Plan) to incorporate Revised Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) for Nutrients in Lake Elsinore and Canyon Lake (Basin Plan Amendment).

Background

The Santa Ana Water Board adopted the Basin Plan amendment on July 25, 2025 by [Resolution No. R8-2025-0014](#). The Resolution incorporates a revision to the 2004 Nutrient TMDLs that includes adding milestones and interim numeric targets, revising final numeric targets, waste load and load allocations, final compliance dates and the implementation plan.

Requirements for Submitting Comments

The State Water Board will not accept any new evidence not already presented to the Regional Water Board during its consideration of the Basin Plan Amendment. In accordance with 23 Cal. Code Regs., § 3779, subd. (f), the State Water Board may refuse to accept any comments that do not satisfy all the following requirements:

1. Comments must specifically address the final version of the Basin Plan Amendment adopted by the Santa Ana Water Board.
2. If the Santa Ana Water Board previously responded to a similar or identical comment, the commenter must explain why and in what manner the commenter believes each of the responses provided by the Santa Ana Water Board to each comment was inadequate or incorrect.
3. The commenter also must include either a statement that each of the comments was timely raised before the Santa Ana Water Board, or an explanation of why the commenter was unable to raise the specific comment before the Santa Ana Water Board.
