PETITION OF AES REDONDO BEACH, LLC, FOR REVIEW OF THE LOS ANGELES REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD'S FAILURE TO ADOPT A TIME SCHEDULE ORDER FOR THE REDONDO BEACH GENERATING STATION ORDER R4-2016-0222-A01: ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF PETITION IN ABEYANCE AND SUBSEQUENT REQUEST TO ACTIVATE PETITION

This will acknowledge the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board's) receipt of your petition and request that the petition be held in abeyance on January 7, 2022, and the State Water Board's subsequent receipt of your request to remove the petition from abeyance and activate it on March 24, 2022. It is important that you review the relevant dates below carefully because they identify timelines for State Water Board review of your petition, but also affect your ability to seek judicial review of the regional water quality control board's action or inaction.

Please note that State Water Board regulations provide that this petition will be dismissed by operation of law effective on June 23, 2022, unless one of the following events occurs prior to 5:00 p.m. on June 22, 2022. This petition will be deemed dismissed effective June 23, 2022 **unless:**

- (1) the State Water Board has notified the regional water quality control board and interested persons that they have 30 days to respond to the petition (the State Water Board will send a copy of the notification to the petitioner);
- (2) the State Water Board has received a written request from the petitioner to place this petition back in abeyance; or
- (3) the State Water Board has already notified the petitioner that the petition is dismissed.

If none of these events occurs prior to 5:00 p.m. on June 22, 2022, this petition will be automatically dismissed effective on June 23, 2022 without further action by the State Water Board. Dismissal of a petition, whether by operation of law or by a letter issued by the State Water Board, is a final agency action for purposes of seeking judicial review of the regional water quality control board's action or inaction. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23, § 2050.5, subd. (e).)
