## Agricultural Lands Regulatory Program Fee Schedule Methodology Options

### Option 1 – Irrigation and Nitrogen Management Plan and Pesticide/Toxicity Management Plan

Management Plan Tiers	Individual Enrollment (Not in a 3rd Party Group)	Enrolled in an Approved 3rd Party Group
<b>1</b>	\$12.60 per acre	\$1.05 per acre
<b>2</b>	\$10.71 per acre	\$0.89 per acre
<b>3</b>	\$9.10 per acre	\$0.76 per acre

1 – Discharger or group of dischargers that ~~must develop Irrigation and Nitrogen Management Plans (INMP) and Pesticide/Toxicity Management Plans (PTMP)~~ are required to develop a surface water and groundwater management plan in response to an identified impact.

2 – Discharger or group of dischargers that ~~must develop INMP or PTMP~~ are required to develop a surface water or groundwater management plan in response to an identified impact, but not both.

3 – Discharger or group of dischargers that are not required to develop ~~both an INMP and a PTMP~~ a surface water or groundwater management plan.

INMP Requirement	Individual Enrollment (Not in a 3rd Party Group)	Enrolled in an Approved 3rd Party Group
<b>Will be required to have an INMP by 2023 All growers except those noted below</b>	\$12.24 per acre	\$1.02 per acre
<b>Not required to have an INMP Those growers determined to not be required to have an INMP</b>	\$10.40 per acre	\$0.87 per acre

### Option 3 – By Defined Agricultural Activity

Defined Agricultural Activity	Individual Enrollment (Not in a 3rd Party Group)	Enrolled in an Approved 3rd Party Group
<b>All Agricultural Lands activities except those listed below</b>	\$12.24 per acre	\$1.02 per acre
<b>Rice, Irrigated Pasture, and Managed Wetlands Growers belonging to the California Rice Commission; as well as Irrigated Pasture and Managed Wetlands who do not apply additional nitrogen.</b>	\$10.40 per acre	\$0.87 per acre
