Enclosed is Complaint No. R2-2008-0100 for an administrative civil liability in the amount of \$490,000. The Complaint alleges that the C&H Sugar Company, Inc. violated the following requirements of its Permit for Discharges from the refinery and the Joint Treatment Plant to Surface Waters NPDES Permit No. CA 003741:

Order No. 00-025

- Discharge Prohibition A.5
- Effluent Limitations 1.a, 3, 4, 8 for BOD₅, Total Coliform, residual chlorine, mercury and nickel
- Storm water limitations C.1 for pH

Order No. R2-2007-0032

- Effluent Limitation for Discharge Point 001, 1. BOD₅ and 3. Bis(2ethylhexyl)phthalate
- Effluent Limitations for Discharge Point 002, 2. Total coliform, 3. Cyanide.
- Storm water limitations F for pH and visible oil

There were a total of 54 violations over the reporting period July 1, 2005 to October 31, 2008. The Complaint describes the alleged violations in detail. As discussed below, C&H Sugar may be allowed to spend up to \$245,000 on a supplemental environmental project (SEP) that is acceptable to the Assistant Executive Officer.

- C&H Sugar Company, Inc. can appear before the Regional Water Board at the meeting to
 contest the matter. Written comments and evidence shall be submitted by the deadline
 indicated below and in accordance with the process set forth in the attached Public Notice.
 At the meeting, the Regional Water Board may impose an administrative civil liability in the
 amount proposed or for a different amount, decline to seek civil liability, or refer the case to
 the Attorney General for judicial enforcement.
- 2. C&H Sugar Company, Inc. can waive the right to a hearing to contest the allegations contained in the Complaint by completing the waiver attached to the Complaint.

If C&H Sugar Company, Inc. waives its right to a hearing, it must mail and fax a copy of the signed waiver by the time and date specified below to the attention of Derek Whitworth of my staff at (510) 622-2349.

The deadline for submittal of written comments and evidence to the Complaint and waiver is **January 12, 2009**, at 5 p.m.

The deadline for submittal of an SEP proposal(s) is **January 26, 2009**, at 5 p.m.
