SUBJECT: Mt. View Sanitary District, Wastewater Treatment Plant,

Martinez, Contra Costa County - Reissuance of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: August 2000 - NPDES Permit Reissued

DISCUSSION: Mt. View Sanitary District's wastewater treatment plant provides

advanced secondary treatment of about 2 million gallons per day of wastewater from a 6-square mile area within the City of Martinez. The District routes treated wastewater to constructed wetlands prior to discharging it to Peyton Slough, a tributary to Carquinez Strait.

The District, Bay Area Clean Water Agencies, and U.S. EPA

commented on Board staff's draft permit. Our response to comments is attached in Appendix C. The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A)

reflects all changes made in response to comments.

The most significant comments came from U.S. EPA, regarding our use of new copper data, and requirements for chronic toxicity monitoring. To address U.S. EPA's concerns, we revised the

Tentative Order to (a) include an expiration date of May 17, 2010, so copper limits will be reevaluated in a timely manner, and (b) require that the District conduct chronic toxicity monitoring. We believe that

these changes bring resolution to these issues.
