SUBJECT:	LEAKING UNDERGROUND FUEL TANK CLEANUP PROGRAM – Status Report
DISCUSSION:	Attached are three graphs (Table 1) indicating progress made during the first quarter of fiscal year 2005-06 toward our underground storage tank (UST) program goals. Our accomplishments to date are below target, due to recent staff reassignments and recent efforts to expand our public participation efforts to a full range of cleanup sites (including UST cases). We have a number of UST cases poised for closure in the next several months, which will get us back on track to meet our goals for case closure. Additionally, we have added two new students to the UST program to help with database management, which will allow us to accurately reflect progress in all the major UST program categories. Our UST caseload increased in September with the addition of about 65 UST cases in San Rafael. We are coping with this additional caseload without any additional staff resources through a combination of case prioritization and case reassignment among existing cleanup staff.
