## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING on AMENDMENT OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDER for CITY OF PACIFICA, WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM in

PACIFICA. SAN MATEO COUNTY

Water Board staff has developed a tentative order that would amend Cease and Desist Order No. R2-2011-0031 (CDO) that was issued by the Water Board to require the City to take necessary actions to reduce and eliminate sanitary sewer overflows from its wastewater collection system. The tentative order would amend the CDO to require use of condition assessment methodologies that are more appropriate for the Sharp Park and Linda Mar force mains, and would allow the City an additional 9 months to complete the assessment.

The City owns and operates the wastewater collection system that serves about 39,000 people in the City. The system consists of gravity sewers, five force mains, and five pump stations. The system feeds the City's Calera Creek Water Recycling Plant.

Written comments on or objections to the tentative order must be received by the Water Board no later than **5 p.m. on January 14, 2013**, and must be sent to the attention of **Lila Tang**, so that such comments may be considered. No written comments will be accepted or responded to in writing after that date.

The Water Board is scheduled to consider adoption of the tentative order during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m., February 13, 2013, in the first floor auditorium of the Elihu Harris State Building, 1515 Clay Street, Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at the public hearing on this matter. The Water Board will hear oral testimony, but will not accept written comments after the deadline noted above.

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Water Board at the public hearing or in timely submitted written correspondence delivered to the Water Board.
