**NOTICE OF
OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
TENTATIVE CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER**

The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff has prepared a Tentative Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) on January 13, 2017. The Tentative CAO alleges that Timothy Starkweather, Jean A. Porlier, and Joan L. Boblitt (collectively, the Dischargers) are responsible for unauthorized discharges of fill placed into the wetland at Alameda County Assessor Parcel Numbers 902-0008-005-05 and 902-0008-005 at Los Colinas Road, Livermore (Site) and proposes that the Dischargers clean up and abate the effects of the authorized fill placed on the Site.

The Water Board is providing a 10-day comment period to allow comments on the Tentative CAO. **The deadline for submitting written comments is 5:00 p.m. on January 23, 2017.** Comments must be sent to the attention of Yan Nusinovich. **Comments received after the deadline or on any subject other than the Tentative CAO will not be considered.**

Pursuant to section 2050(c) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, any party that challenges the Water Board's action on this matter through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues or objections that were raised before the Water Board in timely submitted written correspondence delivered to the Water Board.
