NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER
in the matter of
CITY OF HALF MOON BAY
SAN MATEO COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and the City of Half Moon Bay (City) have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order impose an administrative civil liability against the City in the amount of \$26,400 for 12 unauthorized discharges to waters of the United States.

This proposed liability is for alleged violations of the Clean Water Act Section 301 and Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems for 12 sanitary sewer overflows totaling approximately 12,560 gallons to waters of the United States between May 2, 2007, and December 31, 2017.

The Proposed Settlement would allow \$13,400 to be suspended pending completion of an enhanced compliance action (ECA) to deploy SmartCover© or equivalent systems within the City's collection system to track flows, to understand flow patterns and potential sources of inflow and infiltration, and to help prevent sanitary sewer overflows.
