**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND
PUBLIC HEARING FOR TIME SCHEDULE ORDER**

**County of Santa Clara
Oregon Expressway Underpass
Intersection of Oregon Expressway and Alma Street, Palo Alto, Santa Clara County**

Board staff has prepared a draft time schedule order for County of Santa Clara in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The County of Santa Clara owns and operates the Oregon Expressway Underpass, and treats and discharges groundwater and stormwater containing volatile organic compounds (VOCs) from the underpass to Matadero Creek. The draft time schedule order sets forth requirements for the County to comply with the VOC and Fuel General Permit (Order No. R2-2017-0048), as amended by Order No. R2-2018-0050 on November 14, 2018.

The deadline for receipt of comment on draft time schedule order is 5:00 p.m. on April 1, 2019. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Marcos De la Cruz**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft time schedule order during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **May 8, 2019**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to attend and express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
