**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON  
RESCISSION OF SITE CLEANUP REQUIREMENTS FOR  
PHILLIPS 66 COMPANY FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT CONCORD NAVAL  
WEAPONS STATION AND 330 HOLLY DRIVE, CONCORD, CONTRA COSTA  
COUNTY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order (Order) for rescinding Site Cleanup Requirements (SCRs) for the Phillips 66 Company (The Discharger).

The Order would rescind the current Site Cleanup Requirement for soil and groundwater. The Order summarizes the basis for rescission stating the discharger has met both soil and groundwater cleanup levels based on post-excavation confirmation soil sampling and groundwater monitoring. The discharger has submitted a technical report that details compliance with the 2016 order and describes how site conditions meet the criteria for low-threat closure.
