NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER in the matter of CALATLANTIC GROUP, INC., CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region, Regional Water Board prosecution staff and CalAtlantic Group, Inc. have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order impose an administrative civil liability against CalAtlantic Group, Inc. in the amount of \$549,600 for alleged violations of Construction Stormwater General Permit (NPDES No. CAS000002, Order No. 2009-0009-DWQ).

This proposed liability is based on allegations that CalAtlantic Group, Inc. violated the Construction Stormwater General Permit by failing to implement appropriate erosion control, sediment control, and perimeter control best management practices during construction and discharging sediment-laden stormwater to Bollinger Canyon Creek, a water of the State and United States. These alleged violations, which occurred between November 2018 and January 2019, are associated with construction of The Preserve Project, a residential development in the City of San Ramon.
