**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Lehigh Southwest Cement Company
Permanente Plant
24001 Stevens Creek Blvd., Cupertino, Santa Clara County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The discharger operates the Permanente Plant, a limestone quarry and former cement manufacturing facility that currently processes minerals and produces construction aggregate from limestone and other stone quarried onsite. The draft permit addresses all wastewater (including industrial stormwater) associated with quarrying and crushed rock mining and processing at the Facility. Wastewater is treated to remove selenium and other pollutants before discharge to Permanente Creek. Industrial stormwater is treated by settling ponds before discharge to Permanente Creek.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is **5:00 p.m. on August 25, 2025**. Comments must be sent to the **attention of John H. Madigan**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at **9:00 a.m. on October 8, 2025**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
