**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Cities of South San Francisco and San Bruno and North Bayside System Unit (NBSU)**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System general permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The Cities of South San Francisco and San Bruno own the Water Quality Control Plan, which treats about 8 million gallons of wastewater per day for discharge to San Francisco Bay through the North Bayside System Units submerged diffuser located approximately 5,300 feet offshore from Point San Bruno

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft order is **5:00 p.m. on March 9, 2024**. Comments must be sent to the **attention of Jerry Xu**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft order during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **April 8, 2026**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
