**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING
FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency
Export and Storage Facilities
7176 Johnson Drive, Pleasanton, Alameda County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

This draft permit would regulate the intermittent discharges of secondary-treated and disinfected wastewater to San Lorenzo Creek and Alamo Canal through shallow-water outfalls during extreme wet weather; these discharges could occur up to about once every 1.5 years. The draft permit would also regulate occasional discharge to these waterbodies to ensure outfall operability. The Livermore-Amador Valley Water Management Agency (LAVWMA) owns, and the Dublin San Ramon Services District operates, the LAVWMA Export and Storage Facilities. Most discharges from these facilities occur in Lower San Francisco Bay through a deepwater outfall and are covered under a separate permit.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is **5:00 p.m. on July 6, 2026**.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **August 12, 2026**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
