Session Description

Over 5,000 municipal stormwater permittees are required to develop a post-construction program to address stormwater runoff from new development and redevelopment. The post-construction programs must include requirements to install BMPs and ensure maintenance of those BMPs. To implement an effective program, municipalities need to look beyond the individual site to assess how post-construction controls will affect the entire watershed. This presentation will describe the post-construction program requirements and how innovative programs such as **Low Impact Development and Smart Growth** can be used to help meet these requirements.
