To Consider Re-Adoption of Resolution No. R3-2008-0002 Amending the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coast Basin to

- (1) Remove the Shellfish Harvesting Beneficial Use for Soquel Lagoon,
- (2) Add the Soquel Lagoon Watershed to the Human Fecal Material Discharge Prohibition and the Domestic Animal Waste Discharge Prohibition, And
 - (3) Adopt the Total Maximum Daily Loads for Pathogens in Soquel Lagoon, Soquel Creek, and Noble Gulch, Santa Cruz, California

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board Central Coast Region (Central Coast Water Board) will hold a public hearing to consider adoption of a resolution amending the Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan) for the Central Coast Basin. If accepted, the resolution will amend the Basin Plan by (1) removing the shellfish harvesting beneficial use in Soquel Lagoon, (2) adding the Soquel Lagoon Watershed to the Human Fecal Material Discharge Prohibition and the Domestic Animal Waste Discharge Prohibition, and (3) incorporating Total Maximum Daily Loads for Pathogens in Soquel Lagoon, Soquel Creek, and Noble Gulch. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Central Coast Water Board will consider approval of the proposed revised resolution. The Basin Plan establishes measures to protect beneficial uses of water and achieve water quality objectives.

The Central Coast Water Board adopted resolution R3-2008-0002 in March 2008. The current action is to re-adopt a revised version of the resolution. Most of these revisions are minor typographical corrections; some are substantive changes. The current staff report associated with the proposed revised resolution includes a discussion of the substantive changes.

Actions to amend the Basin Plan by the Central Coast Water Board will be taken in accordance with a regulatory program exempt under section 21080.5 of the Public Resources Code from the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report under the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, section 21000 et seq.) and with other applicable laws and regulations.

Your timely submittal will allow staff and the Central Coast Water Board members to consider your comments before taking final action at the meeting to be held on May 8, 2009.

Time limits may be imposed on oral presentations at the hearing. At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Central Coast Water Board will consider certification of the substitute environmental documents and approval of the proposed amendments. The Central Coast Water Board may close the public hearing and the comment period, but consider adoption of the amendments at a later public hearing.
