## Re: City of Salinas Municipal Storm Water Permit CA 0049981; Draft Order No. R3-2012-0005 Associated Program Costs

Dear Mr. Thomas:

Pursuant to the request from your staff and Board Members we are providing updated cost increases for implementation of the City of Salinas Municipal Storm Water Permit CA 0049981; Draft Order No. R3-2012-0005. We very much appreciate your Staff allowing us the extra few days we needed to complete our review of the information you will find attached.

We have significantly revised our cost estimates based on the information we have received from Water Board Staff Members over the past two weeks. In providing these numbers we have indentified only those costs for which we could provide hard numbers based on professional estimates to provide services. Increased costs for the sweeping of parking lots and increased costs for monitoring are the two areas where we can provide concrete data.

There are spread sheets attached for each of these two items. The first item addresses costs for monitoring receiving waters. Following strict adherence to Section E. Municipal Maintenance, Part 12 River as we understand it could result in an increased cost of \$685,000 over the course of the permit. However, we understand that there is likely more work to be done in determining the amount of monitoring associated with the Salinas River Outfall. Given this understanding we also looked at the minimum amount of monitoring that may be required and have concluded that at a minimum we would expect monitoring costs to increase \$173,000 over the course of the permit. We expect that the amount will fall somewhere between the two and City Staff will also be completing a Request for Proposals for monitoring services in the next few months to ensure that we are paying market rate.

The second area of costs that City Staff identified is the increase in contract sweeping of parking lots as specified in the permit. Based on bids we received from sweeping companies we expect these costs increase to total \$97,600 over the course of the permit.

We do understand that our cost estimates are well below those that we initially presented. They have been significantly reduced based on our exchange of information with WB Staff and with our inability to accurately predict hard costs for some elements of the permit. For example we know in the third year of the permit that our sweeping program will be required to either add a parking control or educational element. We expect that the revised program will be a

combination of the two but until we work our way "into" the permit and work with WB Staff we cannot determine the actual increased program and enforcement costs, so have refrained from including them. Additionally, we know that there will be an increase in costs associated with trash containment devices to prevent debris from entering receiving waters. Until we complete an assessment and study we will be unable to predict the increase in these costs so have declined to include those as well.

We have very much appreciated the open dialogue with WB Staff that has resulted in an increased understanding of expectations for our compliance with the permit and look forward to continuing our working relation that will result in a final permit adopted and in place so that the City can begin implementation.

- 12. **River Outfall** Within 12 months of adoption of this Order, the Permittee shall develop and submit to the Central Coast Water Board Executive Officer for approval, a plan to decrease the pollutant loads (including Salinas nutrients, salts, pathogen indicators, and pesticides) discharged from the Salinas River outfall. The plan shall include:
  - a) Pollutant source identification;
  - b) Ranking of pollutant sources in terms of priority;
  - c) Identification of actions that will provide measurable pollutant load reduction outcomes;
  - d) Ranking of actions in terms of expected effectiveness;
  - e) Identification of actions to be implemented;
  - f) An implementation schedule;
  - g) Measurable pollutant load reduction outcomes;
